Three Arrested for Commercial Burglary

Officers responded to 865 W Foothill Blvd (Aurora Modern Healing) regarding a commercial burglary investigation. Upon arrival, officers conducted their investigation and determined the suspects gained entry into the business through an unsecured roof hatch, at approximately 0030hrs. Once inside, the suspect(s) stole numerous electronic items and fled the location. Later that morning, the victim called to advise one of the eletronic devices was activated and the GPS showed it was in the area of Foothill Blvd/Sumner Av, Pomona. Officers responded and two subjects were contacted. A search of their belongings was conducted and both subjects were found to be in possession of stolen property from the burglary. The two were taken into custody and transported to the Claremont PD Jail, where they were booked and later released on a citation.

Later that afternoon, the victim called and more of the electronic devices GPS signals showed in the area of Towne Av/Vinton Av, Pomona. Officers drove to the area and contacted several subjects. In a panic, one of the subjects swollowed fentanyl. LA County Fire arrived, provided medical care and transported the subject to PVHMC. While providing medical attention to the one subject, officers recognized another suspect they saw on surveillence cameras commit the burglary earlier that morning. The suspect was detained and found to be in possession of stolen property. The suspect was placed under arrest for burglary and transported to the Claremont PD Jail, where he was booked and released on a citation.
